- character traits. How are they different from physical traits? Which character from their Patricia Polacco book did s/he and his/her partner choose to write about? Which three character traits did they choose? Why?
- expanded form of numbers. What would the expanded form of 3,281 be? $3,000 + 200 + 80 + 1$
- the problem and solution of a story. Every story has a problem and a solution. What are the main problem and solution of his/her Patricia Polacco book?
- words that make up contractions. Give three examples!
- Halloween! Tell all about the parade and the party! What did s/he write on his/her Halloween acrostic poem?
- The Hundred Dresses. Who are Maddie, Peggy and Wanda? What is the relationship between these three girls?
- how to measure with a ruler to the closest inch, half inch, quarter inch!

- The Legend of the Indian Paintbrush. What did we learn about legends from this book? What is a legend? We started writing our legends in Writer's Workshop. What legend is s/he explaining?
- something new s/he learned about this week's Star of the Week:
