

## **Fairy Tale (different ending) Book Report Instructions**

A fairy tale is a story usually written for children. They include elements of magic and magical folk such as fairies, elves, wizards, princes, princesses, or goblins. They often have a happy ending.

Read a fairy tale. Explain briefly (one paragraph) how the book you read actually ends. Give enough information for the reader to understand the characters and ending. Then write your own, different ending to the book as if you were the author. Use character names and dialogue. For example:

Cinderella turned and saw her slipper on the stairs to the castle. "There she is!" yelled the prince. Cinderella grabbed her slipper and ran into the woods...

Your own, different ending should be at least one paragraph long. Start with a draft. Remember to have an adult help you to edit your report. It should be proofread for complete sentences and proper spelling and grammar.
