

Historical Fiction Book Report Instructions

You will be getting two grades for this assignment. One will be on your written report. The other will be on your presentation.

Choose a **main character** from your story. In the first person (from your character's point of view), describe the setting* and provide a summary of what your character experienced in the book.

This is a prompt to help you start your report:

Your report should summarize what happened in the beginning, middle, and end of the story. Explain the problem and solution. **Remember, all of this should be from the character's point of view.**

***Setting (where and when)**

When you describe the setting, make sure to include real historical events that took place during this time period (2 things that will help the reader become more acquainted with the setting).

Example: My story takes place in France during World War II.

As always, spelling, punctuation, and neatness will count toward your grade.

Presentation.

You will be reading your report to your classmates. You are encouraged to dress up, bring props, and be creative for your presentation, but this is optional. Your teacher will give you your presentation date. Make sure you practice your presentation before turning in your report. Remember to speak loudly and clearly.

Please note: Time Travel type books such as Magic Tree House, Time Warp Trio, and Dan Gutman's Jackie & Me, are not appropriate for this assignment.
