

# Stand-Up Time Line

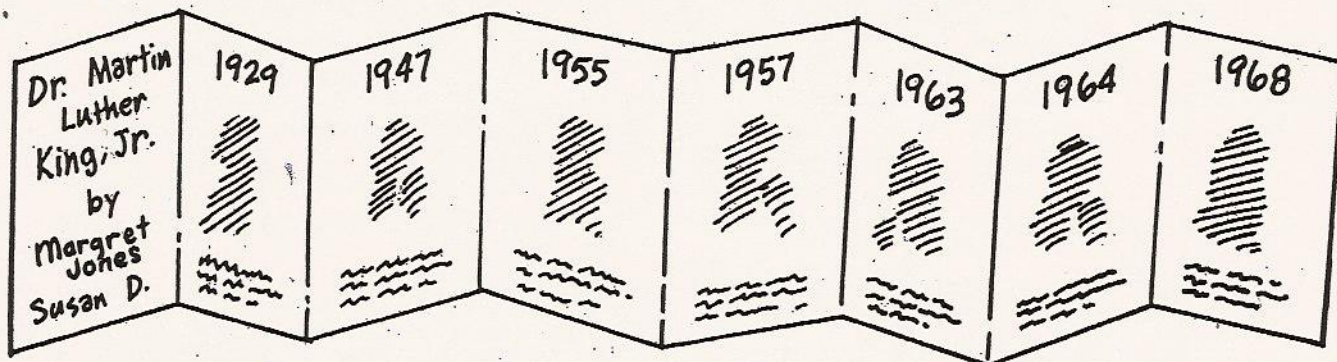
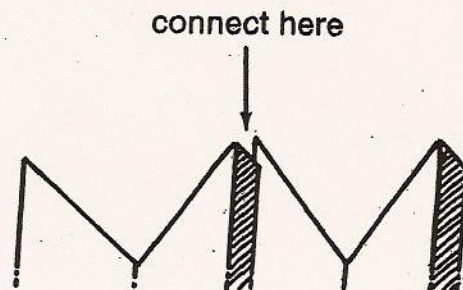
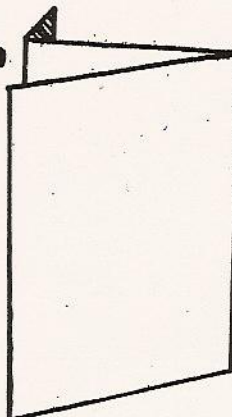
Make a stand-up time line about a book you have read.

## You need:

four sheets of ~~construction~~ **8½" x 11"**  
 construction paper  
 crayons  
 glue

## Directions:

1. Fold a ½" edge on one side of each sheet of paper. Then fold the paper in half, as shown.
2. Connect the four sheets by gluing the ½" folded edge to the next sheet as shown.



3. On the first panel write the title, author, and your name.
4. To make the time line, write seven important dates in order on the top of the panels as shown. If your book does not give dates, use the words first, second, third, fourth, fifth, sixth, and last for your panels.
5. Write a sentence at the bottom of each panel describing the event.
6. Illustrate each event above its description.
